John R. Brumm, age 84, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Friday, September 2, 2016 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

In 1969, the family moved to Mason City, Iowa where John was a salesman for International Harvester. While in Mason City, John enjoyed being an usher for Holy Family Catholic Church. He eventually delivered auto parts for Arnold Motor Supply. After many endeavors, John retired in 1997.

In 2007, John and Mary moved to Storm Lake. He was currently a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church. He was a life-long Knights of Columbus member.

John liked collecting John Deere memorabilia and had many toy model trucks. He was an avid Iowa State Cyclones and Minnesota Twins fan. John enjoyed fishing, golfing, and sharpening blades.
