Joseph R. Kramer, 56, passed away Sunday, February 28, 2021 at Horn Memorial Hospital in Ida Grove of cardiac arrest.

Joe was the 7th of 8 children born to Leon and Gladys Kramer. He grew up on the family farm southeast of Fonda, attending OLGK grade school and graduating from Fonda Community High School in 1982.
