June 29, 1917 - February 18, 2022

Leila L. Grohe, age 104, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on February 18, 2022, at Methodist Manor in Storm Lake.

Memorial services will take place Saturday, April 2, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Schaller. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake is in charge of the arrangements.

Leila (Schwab) Grohe was born June 29, 1917 near Viola Center in Audubon County, the daughter of William Schwab and Anna (Bartelt) Schwab. Leila was baptized into the Christian faith at an early age and was confirmed at the United Methodist Church in Schaller, Iowa. She spent her early years with her parents, brothers, and sisters on the family farm in Audubon County where she received her education and graduation from high school.

On November 14, 1936, Leila was united in marriage to Warren "Hiene" Grohe in Scranton, Iowa and moved to Schaller and was blessed with four daughters: Rosalie, Sharan, Judith, and LaRae. Leila lost her daughter Rosalie in a farm accident at the age of five.

and being with her family.
