Leon Haahr, age 93, of Newell, Iowa died on Sunday, June 10, 2018, at the Newell Good Samaritan Center.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. at Nain Lutheran Church in Newell. Burial will be in the Newell Cemetery. 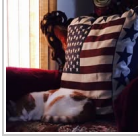
