Linda Fullenworth, age 76, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 at the Trinity Regional Medical Center in Fort Dodge, Iowa.

Church in Carroll. The couple made their home on an acreage on the Lakeside blacktop, where they have lived for 38 years. They often referred to this as "God's little acres" to each other. They enjoyed having Chesapeake Bay Retrievers since 1970-Chessy, Julie and Molly.

In her pastime, Linda enjoyed boating with her husband and spending time with her dogs.
