January 10, 1918 - September 23, 2009

Louis Winterhof, age 91, of Aurelia, Iowa and formerly of Galva, Iowa died Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at Sunset Knoll Care Center in Aurelia. Louis Franz Winterhof was born January 10, 1918 in Cherokee County, Iowa, son of Henry and Lilla (Huseman) Winterhof. He was baptized on January 27, 1918 by Reverend Wehking at St. John's Lutheran Church in Hanover, Iowa and was later confirmed in the Lutheran faith in 1931. Louis received his education in a country school just a few miles from his home place. Louis resided with his parents, was a farm hand and worked for Bill Suling shelling corn for farmers in the area. He moved to Galva, Iowa around 1957 and was employed by the Galva Lumber Yard for 14 years. After the Lumber Yard closed, he did started custom painting in Galva and surrounding areas. Left to cherish his memory are his sisters, Verna Witt of Windom, Minnesota and Delores (Bob) Popp of Marshalltown, Iowa; nieces; nephews; extended family and friends.
