



## Lowell Gene Fields

December 22, 1944 - February 27, 2012

Lowell Fields, age 67, of Storm Lake, Iowa died February 27, 2012 at Mercy Medical Center in Sioux City. Lowell Gene Fields was born December 22, 1944 in Spencer, Iowa the son of Bradley and Leona (Bauman) Fields. He was baptized at the United Methodist Church in Royal, Iowa where he was later confirmed. Growing up, Lowell attended school in Royal where he graduated from Royal High School in 1962. Lowell was proud of being a foster parent and received the Foster Parent of the Year Award in Iowa and the Dan Chavez – Beyond the Horizons ESL Teacher of the Year Award. Lowell loved gardening and camping. He enjoyed traveling, especially to Mexico. In his spare time, he attended different area churches where he spoke about the Justice To Our Neighbors Program.
