Lyle Jackson, 82, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on Friday, December 20, 2019 at the Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

In October of 1955, Lyle enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. During his time of service, he served in Okinawa. Lyle was honorably discharged in October of 1961.

Throughout his working career, Lyle worked at Hygrade and in maintenance and engineering at BVRMC. He retired in March of 1999.
