Lyle Peters, age 78, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Monday, October 27, 2014 in Fort Dodge, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, October 30, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. at Grace Lutheran Church in Storm Lake with military rites by the Storm Lake AMVETS Post #66 to follow.
