Lynn M. Hogrefe, age 64, of Storm Lake, Iowa died April 14, 2016 in Onawa, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday, April 20, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. at Grace Lutheran Church in Storm Lake. Burial will be in the Zion Lutheran Cemetery in rural Storm Lake. 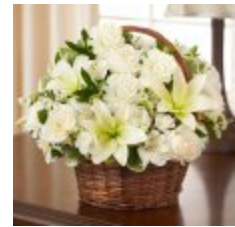
