



Mark J. Schwarzkopf

January 15, 1944 - September 29, 2012

Mark J. Schwarzkopf, age 68, of Lake View, Iowa died September 29, 2012 at Loring Hospital in Sac City, Iowa. Schwarzkopf attended elementary grades in Lake View, Iowa and was a graduate of St. Bernard High School in Breda, Iowa. He attended Rockhurst University in Kansas City, Missouri in 1965, but soon enlisted in the US Army in 1965. Schwarzkopf worked as a sports writer for the 'USACOM Chronicle' when he served with the U.S. Army in Germany from 1965 to 1968. He later worked as a sports writer and general assignment reporter for a 21,000-circulation newspaper published by the Seventh Army Support Command. He also served as civilian editor for the 'Alpinist' newspaper published by the United States Army School in Oberammergau, Germany, for 2½ years. Upon returning to the USA, he earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Portland, Oregon in 1977 and then moved back to Lake View, Iowa where he remained since 1980. His survivors include 2 children, Phillip S. Schwarzkopf and wife Christin (Zipser) of Spartanburg, SC and daughter, Amy C. Schwarzkopf of Seattle, WA; and one grandchild, Sophia A. Schwarzkopf; and 3 siblings, Lynne A. Schwarzkopf of Riverside, CA, John B. Schwarzkopf and wife (Cynthia Griffin) of Royse City, TX, and Paul L. Schwarzkopf and partner, Kathleen Forezi of Carroll, IA; 4 nephews; and 1 niece; 2 grand-nephews and 2 grand-nieces. Mark Schwarzkopf was preceded in death by his parents, Bernard J. and Rita Anne Reising/Schwarzkopf, and 2 brothers, David L.
