Maxine Thieking, age 97, of Plattsmouth, Nebraska and formerly of Newell, Iowa died on Friday, November 2, 2018.

Maxine spent her growing up years on the family farm near Fonda, Iowa and attended the Zion Evangelical country church where she was baptized and confirmed. She attended country school until the 8th grade.

On January 26, 1941 Maxine was united in marriage to Gerhard Thieking at St. John Lutheran church in Preston, Iowa. To this union four daughters were born: Myrna Jean, Norma June, Glenda Rae, and Arla Kay. She was a mother and homemaker.

In 1941, Maxine became a member of St. John church in Lytton, Iowa. She

In January of 1975, she joined St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Newell. In Newell, Maxine was active in the community where she delivered Meals on Wheels and helped entertain the residents in the nursing home. Going on bus tours with friends, gardening, baking (especially at Christmas), and handiwork were some of the things she enjoyed doing. Her greatest enjoyment, however, was time spent with her family.
