



Mildred Noethe McCoy

January 8, 1924 - March 29, 2016

Mildred Mary Noethe McCoy, 92, Fonda, Iowa passed away March 29, 2016 peacefully at the Fonda Specialty Care Center with her family at her side.

Funeral Mass will be held Saturday, April 2, 2016 at 10:30 a.m. at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Fonda. Burial will follow in the Mt. Zion Cemetery in Fonda. Visitation will take place Friday, April 1, 2016 from 4-7:00 p.m. with a vigil service at 6:30 p.m. at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Fonda. Millie and Jesse McCoy were united in marriage on November 15, 1997 at OLG Church in Fonda and were married for 13 years until Jesse's passing on June 25, 2011.

Millie was a member of the Catholic Daughters of America for over 50 years. She was also a member of the OLG Holy Family Society and OLG Choir.

She loved bowling and golfing in couples league and ladies league. She was especially proud of her bowling score of 231 in ladies league bowling and her golf score of 36. She was a talented seamstress and cook. She always had that "special tin" of chocolate chip cookies in the freezer for the grandchildren.

Millie was always a loving and gentle caretaker for others. She was a woman of deep faith and dedicated her life to her family. She especially shared a special bond with her youngest daughter, Lisa.

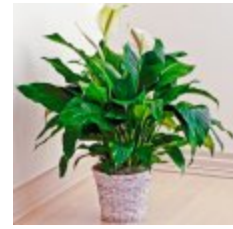
