



## Neil L. Quirin

February 12, 1934 - June 3, 2018

Neil L. Quirin, age 84, of Alta, Iowa died on Sunday, June 3, 2018 at the Sunset Knoll Care & Rehab Center in Aurelia.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, June 7, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. at the Summit Evangelical Free Church in Alta. Burial will be in the Elk Township Cemetery in Alta. Visitation will take place prior to the service from 9:00-11:00 a.m. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Alta is in charge of the arrangements.

Neil L. Quirin, the son of Louis and Elda (Grohe) Quirin, was born on February 12, 1934 in Schaller, Iowa.

In his youth, Neil attended grade school and later graduated from Fairview High School in 1951. He decided to further his education at Iowa State University. He graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agronomy.

On March 21, 1953, Neil was united in marriage to Verna L. Heath. To this union, four children were born: Greg, Mitch, Julie, and Jill. The couple later divorced and on June 7, 1979, Neil married Lavonne Van Berkum at the Milford Baptist Church.

After graduating from Iowa State, Neil started at Spencer Fertilizer Sales Agronomy. He continued, working for Swift & Co Sales and Agronomy covering Southwest Iowa and Southeast Nebraska. Then he was an Extension Agent for ISU Extension. Neil came back to Alta to farm for four years before working for the Gulf Oil Corporation out of Kansas City, Missouri where he focused in Agronomy and served in the areas of the central and western United States, as well as the Prairie Provinces in Canada. Neil stayed working in Kansas City, Missouri as a Director of Seed Division for Farmland Industries.

Neil came back to Alta in 1975 where he started PSA Seed and purchased Mellow-Dent Seeds. In 1982, he organized Co-op Seed with Co-op's home office in Alta. He continued this work until he sold PSA Genetics to Garst Seed in 2000. In this same year, Neil also

started cattle feed and farming while doing centralized seed production for other companies. Neil ended his long and successful career seed production in 2013.

Besides being involved in his work community, Neil served on different boards such as Buena Vista Mutual Insurance, Industrial Development Storm Lake, and Iowa Seed Association. Neil was also involved in the Good News Community Church in Okoboji where he was a member, Elder, and helped on the church's building finance committee.

In his free time, Neil liked driving his John Deere tractor and church planting. Neil enjoyed his work and shared his experience through many speaking engagements.

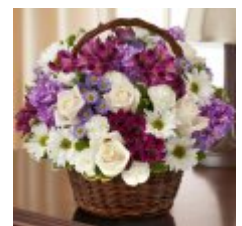
