Nicholas Jay Allen, age 39, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Wednesday, December 18, 2024 in Storm Lake.

Funeral services will take place Monday, December 23, 2024 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Storm Lake. Burial will be in the Storm Lake Cemetery.
