Norbert Huseman, age 85, of Galva, Iowa died Saturday, November 10, 2018 in Ida Grove, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held Friday, November 16, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Johns Lutheran Church in Galva. Burial will be in the church cemetery in rural Galva with full military rites.
