Norma Boisen, age 90, of Schaller, Iowa died Tuesday, July 8, 2014 at the Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

Reformed United Church of Christ in Rural Schaller. To this union, two children were born, Lee Norman and Joanne Kay.

Norma loved music especially playing the organ and piano. She accompanied many soloists while in high school and also played for the Immanual Reformed United Church of Christ services. She also played for many wedding ceremonies over the years.

Norma enjoyed poetry, doing word search, crossword puzzles, and jigsaw puzzles. Norma and her husband Norman liked big bands and going dancing, which they did most Saturdays. She had been on the Schaller park board and was a former Cub Scout den mother. Norma was a witty individual, and always lived her life with spunk.
