Norma Robinson, age 82, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Sunday, January 11, 2009 at Buena Vista Manor in Storm Lake. This union was blessed with one daughter, Naomi. Norma worked side by side with Wendell on farms in Buena Vista and Sac Counties until their retirement, when they moved into Storm Lake in 1983. She was a member of the United Presbyterian Church in Schaller, Iowa, where she was actively involved with women's church group activities. She later transferred her membership to the Lakeside Presbyterian Church in Storm Lake. She was also a member of the Cook Township Merry Gardeners. Norma enjoyed the outdoors and gardening, as well as cooking, canning and baking. She loved

her family and cherished trips around the United States to visit Naomi, as well as the time she spent visiting with her neighbors. Left to cherish her memory are her daughter, Naomi J.
