Norma E. Schemmel, age 81, of Storm Lake, Iowa, formerly of Remsen, Iowa died August 19, 2021 at Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake, Iowa.

Funeral Mass is Tuesday, August 24, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. at the St. Mary's Church in REMSEN, Iowa. Burial will be at the St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery in Remsen, Iowa.
