Pat Fisher, age 64, of Lakeside, Iowa, died Tuesday, March 15, 2016 at the Mercy Medical Center in Sioux City.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, March 19, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Storm Lake. Burial will follow in the Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation will take place Friday, March 18, 2016 from 4-8:00 p.m. at the Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake. 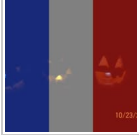
