Patricia (Pat) Ann Baker, age 76, of Storm Lake, Iowa, passed away on April 7, 2026, at Hospice House – the Josie Harper Residence in Omaha, Nebraska, surrounded by her family.

Funeral Mass will take place Wednesday, April 22, 2026 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Storm Lake. Burial will be in the church cemetery. 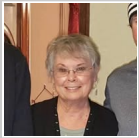
