Rieng Lo, age 64, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Saturday, April 23, 2016.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, April 28, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake. Burial will take place Sunday, May 1, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the Storm Lake Cemetery in Storm Lake. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake is in charge of the arrangements.

Rieng Van Lo was born April 23, 1952 in Son La, Vietnam, the son of Peung Van Lo and Nho Bacht Lo. Rieng was a refugee from Laos when he became a U.S. citizen.

He had a son, Kevin Lo, with his first wife. He later remarried Khamphou Mekdara (deceased) in Storm Lake in 1996.

Rieng spent the past 32 years working at Tyson in Storm Lake. Previously, he was a CNA in Laos and at a refugee camp in Nongkhai, Thailand. Once he moved to the United States, he worked as a CNA at a Methodist Hospital in Des Moines, Iowa and at Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

Rieng was a social person and always enjoyed helping his Asian community in Storm Lake. He will be remembered for his humorous nature and being a

loyal friend to many. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

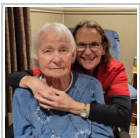
