Robert E. (Bob) Horsfall, age 88, of Storm Lake, IA passed away on August 6, 2012. He was born in Worthington, MN on January 20, 1924. He graduated from high school in Little Rock, IA in 1941. He was a Navy veteran of WW II with active duty in the South Pacific as an aviation torpedo man and also participated in the Navy basketball team. Bob received his B.A. Degree in 1949 in education after coursework at Cornell and Morningside Colleges where he received all conference honors in basketball at both schools. Bob married Donna Wilken of Rock Rapids, Iowa on August 4, 1949. He spent five years as a teacher and coach in Durant, IA and graduated from the University of Iowa with a Master's Degree in school administration in 1954.
