Robert "Bob" Strock Sr., age 82, of Alta, Iowa died Wednesday, June 11, 2014 at Country Side Estates in Cherokee, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held Friday, June 13, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Alta. Burial will be in the Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery.
