



## Roger Allan Schramm

May 3, 1940 - September 28, 2022

Roger Allan Schramm, age 82, of Storm Lake, Iowa died September 28, 2022 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

Funeral services will take place Monday, October 3, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church in Alta, Iowa. Burial will be in Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery in Storm Lake. Roger Allan Schramm was born on May 3, 1940 to Alfred and Alberta (Spurling) Schramm in Sac City, Iowa. He attended school in Early, Iowa, graduating in 1958. He was baptized at the Cook Country Lutheran Church in 1940. Roger was a faithful servant of his Lord and Master, and a long-time member of the Alta Trinity Lutheran Church.

On August 26, 1983 Roger was united in marriage to Diane Sundberg in Bentonville, Arkansas. Together, they owned and operated the Peterson Appliance Store until retirement. Roger continued to service the appliance community long after retirement.

Roger was loved and respected by many in the community. He was known to many as Johnny Cash, because of his 50's hair style and black suits. He loved

to kid with all the business owners and their employees. Roger could be seen either fishing in his boat on Storm Lake or driving his big white Silverado around the town every day, just to make sure everything was alright, especially during COVID.
