Rose Arlene (Lewis) Faine Blair ascended to her heavenly home on February 11, 2025, in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

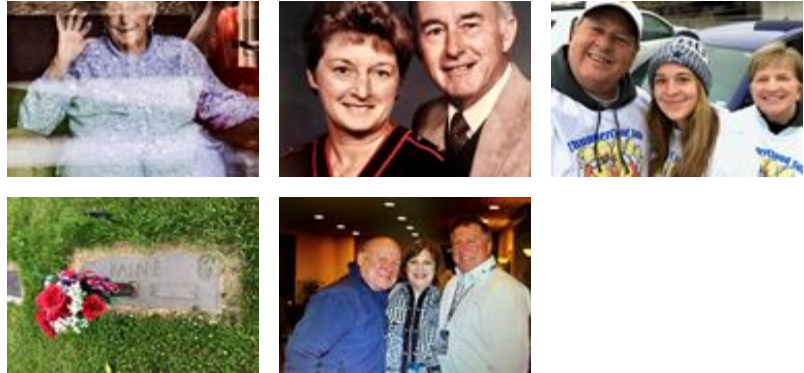
