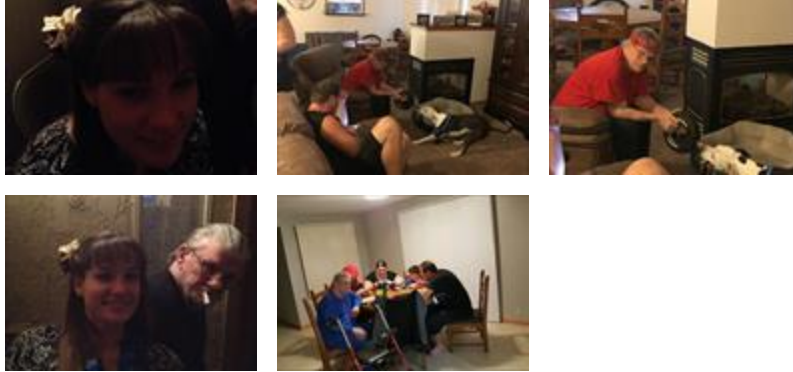
Roy Lawrence, age 84, of Milford, Iowa died June 3, 2021 at his home in Milford, Iowa.

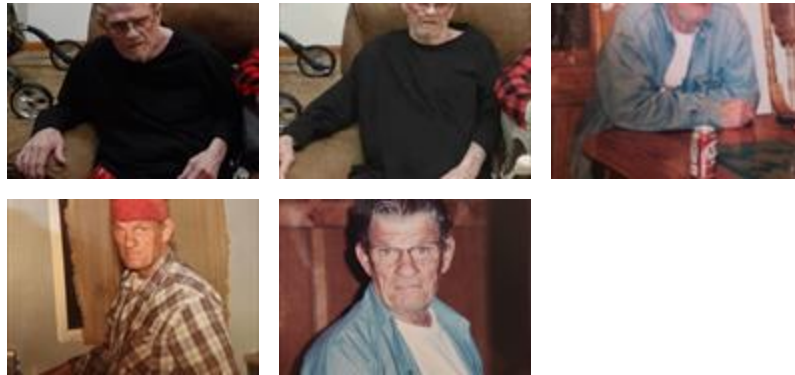
