Ruth V. Schnieders, age 93, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Tuesday, August 1, 2017 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

She and Lester loved ballroom dancing and they shared this passion with their children. Ruth played the piano and gave the girls the love of music and singing.

Ruth lived in Storm Lake for 38 years after she and Lester retired from farming in 1979. They made their home on Kelvin Rd. in Emerald Park. Ruth resided at Otsego Place Assisted Living since 2013. She enjoyed playing cards, dominoes and bingo.

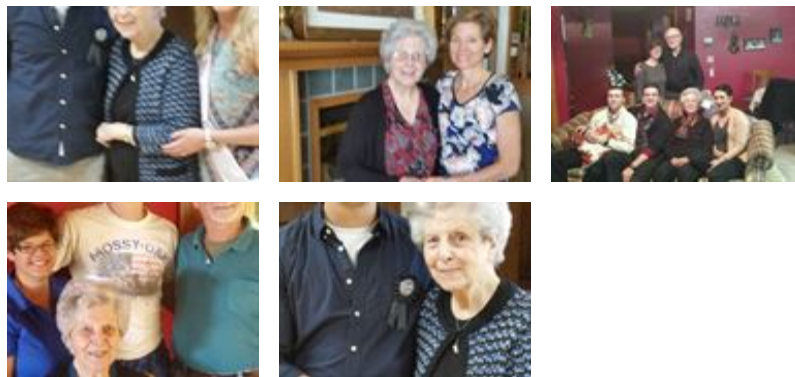

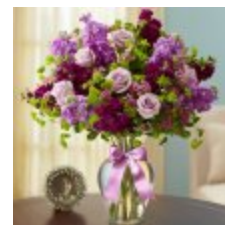

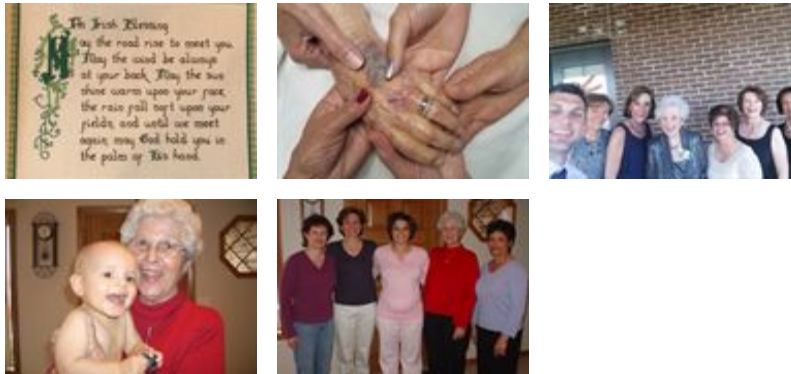
