Ruth Wogahn, age 89, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on Monday, August 19, 2019 at Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

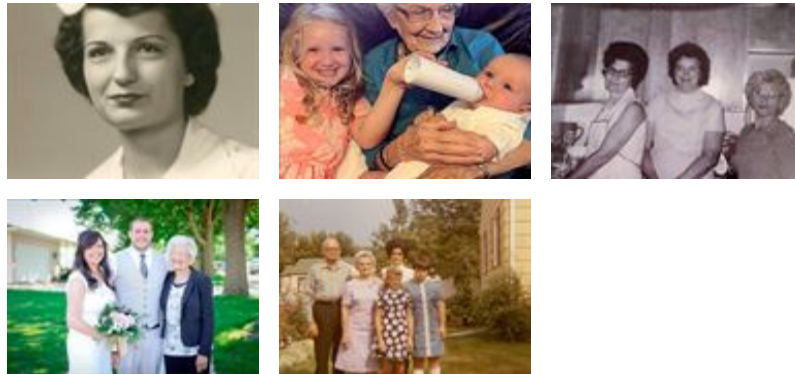

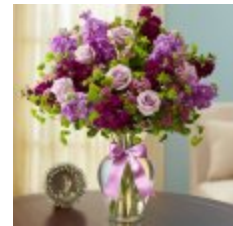
