



## Scott H. Sterler "Skippy"

February 5, 1968 - May 17, 2018

Scott H. Sterler "Skippy", age 50, of Holstein, Iowa, died on May 17, 2018, at the Mercy Medical Center in Sioux City, Iowa.

Memorial services will be held Saturday, May 26, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. at the United Methodist Church in Holstein. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake is in charge of the arrangements.

Scott Henry Sterler, the son of Henry G. and Georgia M. (Schilling) Sterler, was born in Storm Lake, Iowa on February 5, 1968. Growing up, he lived in the Hartley community and graduated from the Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn Community High School in 1986.

On August 6, 1997, Scott was united in marriage to Rhiannon Berger at the United Methodist Church in Hartley. Together, they were blessed with two children, Kayla and Dylan. The couple later divorced.

The majority of Scott's lifetime was spent in the Holstein community where he was employed at VT Industries and he served as a sanitation technician. Scott was known to his many friends as "Skippy."

Scott will be remembered as a man who was always willing to help people, including the elderly, and he thought of others before himself. The greatest

enjoyment he received was riding his motorcycle and snowmobile.
