Steven "Steve" L. Badertscher, age 59, of Sac City, Iowa and formerly of Storm Lake, Iowa passed away surrounded by his loving family on Saturday, February 16, 2019 at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

Memorial services will be held Friday, February 22, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Sac City. Burial will be in the Oakland Cemetery in Sac City. Visitation will take place Thursday, February 21, 2019 from 4-8:00 p.m. at the United Methodist Church in Sac City with the family present from 5:00-8:00 p.m. In lieu of flowers a memorial fund has been established in Steve's name. Steven Lynn Badertscher, the son of William and LeOta (Grable) Badertscher, was born on January 21, 1960 in Tecumseh, Nebraska. Steve was baptized at Maple Grove Church in Tecumseh, Nebraska and later confirmed.

In his youth, Steve attended grade school at Sandridge School District 42. He graduated from Tecumseh High School in 1978. Right out of high school, Steve worked on the wheat harvest throughout the Midwest. He furthered his education after high school by attending Southeast Community College in Beatrice, Nebraska where he received his Associates of Applied Science in Agricultural Business.

Throughout his working career, Steve worked for Sands Livestock, Fletcher Manufacturing, Murphy Family Farms, and Gillis Agricultural Systems, later QC Supply. Steve worked with Gillis/QC Supply from 1990 until 2018.

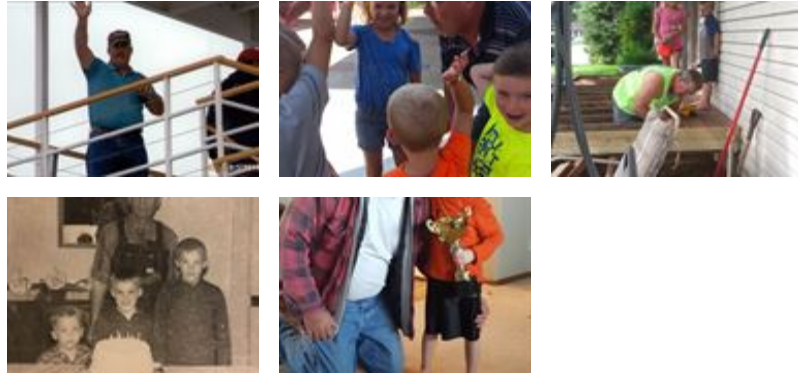

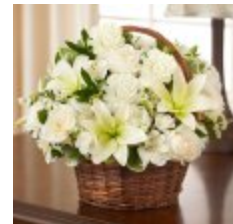
