



Steve "Jado" Tjaden

November 17, 1957 - December 5, 2020

Steven (Jado) Ray Tjaden, age 63, of Aurelia (formerly of Storm Lake) died peacefully in his sleep on Saturday, December 5, 2020 at St. Luke's hospital in Sioux City following a non-COVID-19-related illness.

Private family services will be held on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. at the Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in STORM LAKE. Steve was born on November 17, 1957 in Storm Lake, Iowa, the son of Loren and Myrtle (Marnie) (Lemker) Tjaden. He was educated in the Storm Lake Community School system, graduating in 1976. Following high school, Steve worked at Hygrade and furthered his education, graduating from Buena Vista College in 1985.

Steve dedicated his personal and professional life to helping others – through both work and volunteering. No one missed out on his wit or kind and thoughtful ear whenever they needed or wanted advice. His desire to help led him to earning his Master's degree in Social Work in 2014 from the University of Iowa, ushering in the career and mission he'd always desired.

His current job at United Community Health Center in Storm Lake allowed him to use his gift for helping others as a Mental Health Therapist. He had previous stops in the same role at Siouxland Mental Health in Sioux City and CCUSO in Cherokee.

No matter the situation or where, Steve always brought care and good humor to the table and used that to give the help that was needed. The roots of his calling to be a therapist were in those different lines of work. After Hygrade and graduation from BV, he spent time at Genesis, and the Lutheran Group Home, as well as his first (unofficial) therapy job – the bartender at Puff's.

It was there that Steve met the love of his life, Roxanne Steig. The pair were united in marriage on August 4, 1984 at St Paul's United Methodist Church in Cherokee, Iowa. They built a life together that was always based in love. They welcomed a daughter, Elizabeth Frances, and a son, Benjamin Robert Earl, and raised their children alongside Storm Lake – sharing countless memories and life milestones together. His gregarious humor and confidence – his full-throated rendition of "God Bless America" was a sight to see – made certain there was never a dull moment in the Tjaden household.

He had countless interests, including carving, cooking, reading, learning the guitar and was a co-founder of Albatross Rugby. He was a lifelong fan of the Kansas City Chiefs and the Chicago Cubs, and reveled in his favorite teams' long-awaited recent triumphs.

Steve was the biggest fan, though, of his children and their spouses. Whether it was watching both of his kids perform in marching band, Liz in all her choir and musical theater exploits or Ben's woodworking, golf and trapshooting, their successes brought more joy than anything else could hope to.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Loren and Marnie Tjaden, infant brother Larry Tjaden, his older brother David Tjaden and his wife Beverly, his in-laws Robert and Frances Steig, and brother-in-law Russell Steig.

Left to cherish Steve's memory are his wife Roxanne Tjaden, Aurelia, Iowa; children Elizabeth (Jeremiah) Davis, North Liberty, Iowa; Benjamin (Brooke) Tjaden, Muscatine, Iowa; his pups and grand pups, Mya, Carver, Kinnick, Lilly, and Billy; brother Dan (Diane) Tjaden, North Sioux City, S.D., sister Lori (Mark) Lewis, Checotah, Okla.; brother-in-law Roger (Ruth) Steig, Webster City, IA; sister-in-law Dorothy Steig, Indianola, IA; in addition to aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, and nephews.

“ Steve Tjaden was twenty feet tall in humanity, kindness, good deeds and energy.

We first met in a history class at Buena Vista College in 1984-85 taught by Dr. Cumberland. We had many classes together in the social sciences department. I admired Steve’s intellect and thoughtfulness. Steve was six years older than me, but more worldly by a 100 years. He absorbed knowledge like a sponge. We were young with our lives in front of us.

We became “fast friends” immediately. It was one of those rare friendships that just clicks into place the first time you meet and never waivers, almost telepathic, the cliché “a brother from another mother” describes us well—a rare and cherished human connection. I remember Dr. Perrill commenting on the strength of our friendship and insisting that we make it lifelong, and over the years and miles, we did.

Steve taught me to cook, something I still like to do with full credit for my interest going to Chef Tjaden. We enjoyed trading lunch duties during college at each other’s houses when schedules allowed. He turned mundane tasks of chopping garlic or very, very, very finely chopping cabbage for egg rolls into the most thrilling joy ride achieved through excellent conversation. We have the fondest memories of dinners with Steve and Roxanne and recall there were some fancy cocktails or beers mixed in for good measure. I still crack open those garlic cloves on the side of a chief knife the way Steve taught me, remembering our younger days and my lifelong friend each time.

I imagine many people had this same connection with Steve—he was just that kind of person. Steve regaled us with his “fall down laughing” stories about rugby and life. We could listen to him all day. Will Rogers, Mark Twain, Maya Angelou—had nothing on Steve Tjaden.

I remember when Steve informed us that Roxanne was pregnant (with Elizabeth). The timing was just before we were to leave Storm Lake for Arizona for grad school. He was thrilled, eyes twinkling, smile wide, already a proud father. He again must have inspired, because we soon found our first child on the way too. We have pictures of Elizabeth, "Liz," and our first born, Jacob, together in Storm Lake peaking out a car window together as toddlers. Years later Steve would tell hilarious parenting stories and his "Dad shenanigans".

There were visits across the state occasionally, though we didn't see enough of him and the Tjaden family as we would have liked due to distance and hectic schedules. Social Media and the internet helped keep our families connected as we got older.

*Like George Bailey in the movie *It's a Wonderful Life*, Steve worked in the Storm Lake community making it a better place.*

In 2001, RAGBRAI went through Storm Lake and Steve and Roxanne hosted our large group. Everyone commented on how the entire Tjaden family were the most wonderful people that they had ever met. It was a great reunion.

It's been a tough year with the pandemic separating us. Our 13 year old beagle, Winnie, coincidentally passed on the same day as Steve. In my mind, I picture her snuggling in Steve's lap—there could be no better place, she was a good judge of character and no doubt would love Steve.

To my friend, Steve, you have left us too soon, you made an impression on our hearts and minds forever. Steve Tjaden, you possessed an original and wonderful character. You touched so many lives with joy—we are grateful to know you.

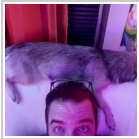

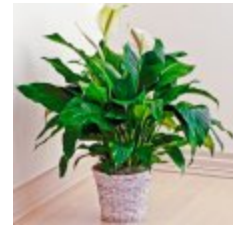
