Susan Ferrin, age 71, of Storm Lake, Iowa, went to be with her Lord and Savior on Wednesday, June 19, 2019. Sue had a difficult multiple-vessel heart bypass in October, 2014 and suffered a heart attack on Wednesday that took her life.

Memorial service will be held on Monday, June 24, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. at the Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in STORM LAKE. Burial will be in the E & R Cemetery in rural Schaller. For the past nine years she lived at the Lakeview Manor Apartments and will be missed by her many friends there. She was always ready to give a kind word of encouragement and after retiring due to back problems she spent many hours enjoying games and reading books.
