Terrence Arthur Stull, known as Ted (Teddy), age 35, passed away unexpectedly October 4, 2021 at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in Iowa City, Iowa. He was born in Ames, Iowa, January 20, 1986 to Terry Allen and Margaret Mary (Moeller) Stull.

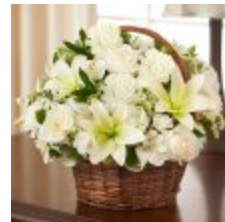
