Timothy K. Bruns, age 64, of Albert City, Iowa died Sunday, May 20, 2012 at his home in rural Albert City. Timothy Keith Bruns was born January 26, 1948, in Garden City, Kansas, the son of Roland and Anna (Staab) Bruns.
