Todd E. Fitzsenry, age 59, of Kalona, Iowa and formerly of Schaller, Iowa, passed away on Monday, January 2, 2023, at his home in Kalona as a result of ongoing health issues.

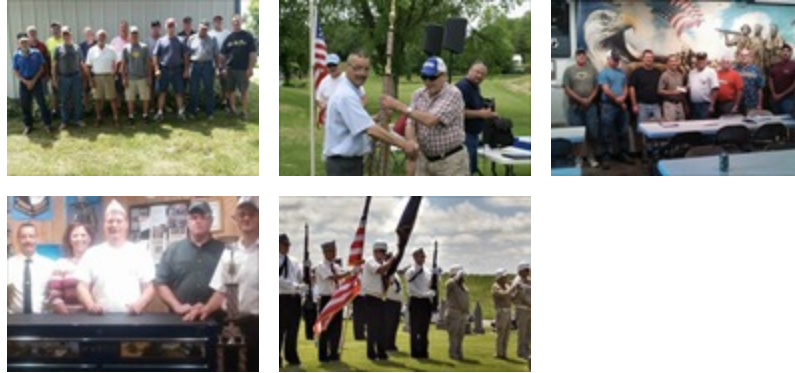
