Todd B. Twombly, age 34, of Storm Lake, Iowa died April 26, 2016 at his home in Storm Lake.

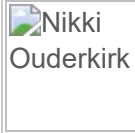

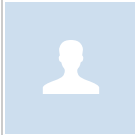
