regular at Buena Vista Raceway in Alta on Wednesday nights throughout the summer. Tom also liked to go fishing and when Toni was younger, he and she would often go to Lake View, as well as many other 'secret spots' they found over the years.

For many years, Tom coordinated golf outings and tournaments for Storm Lake Golf Course and Alta Country Club, before handing over the reins to someone else in 2020.

Tom had a bit of a liking, one could say, for the Iowa Hawkeyes. He never missed watching or listening to Hawkeye basketball games and enjoyed watching them play football as well. He also rooted for the Kansas City Chiefs.
