Verna Ploeger, age 90, of Schaller, Iowa, died Monday, August 24, 2009 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake, Iowa. Verna Viola Sanderman was born September 22, 1918 to Henry and Minnie (Stille) Sanderman in rural Schaller, Iowa. She was baptized into the Christian faith as an infant at Immanuel Reformed Church, rural Schaller and later confirmed as a youth in the same church. She attended Eden Township Country School.
