



## Virgil Allen Nattress

August 2, 1937 - December 6, 2016

Virgil A. Nattress, age 79, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Tuesday, December 6, 2016 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

Memorial services will be Friday, December 9, 2016 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Storm Lake. Burial will follow in the Storm Lake Cemetery. Visitation will take place Thursday, December 8, 2016 from 5-7:00 p.m. at the Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake. In lieu of flowers, a memorial fund has been established. Virgil Allen Nattress was born August 2, 1937 in Spencer, Iowa, the son of Kenneth and Elsie (Marr) Nattress.

Most of all, Virgil was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.
