



## William E. Bradford

April 2, 1923 - April 24, 2017

William E. Bradford, age 94, of Fonda, Iowa died Monday, April 24, 2017 at Loring Hospital in Sac City, Iowa.

Funeral Mass will be held Friday, April 28, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Fonda. Burial will follow in the Mt. Zion Catholic Cemetery in Fonda with full military rites. Visitation will take place one hour prior to the service at the church. The Mahaney Funeral Home in Fonda is in charge of the arrangements.

William Edward Bradford was born April 2, 1923 in Sac County, Iowa, the son of Bernard F. and Anna E. (McGowan) Bradford.

As an infant, he was baptized and later confirmed in the Catholic Church.

Bill attended school at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic School where he graduated in 1940.

On June 9, 1944, Bill joined the United States Marines. He served his country during World War II as an anti-tank gun crewman in the Pacific. Bill participated in action against the enemy at Okinawa. He was honorably discharged on July 18, 1946.

Upon returning home, Bill began his farming devotion. Together with his brother, Bob, they farmed for many years south of Fonda. Bill also homesteaded land in Washington state that he farmed for many years.

Bill was a devoted Catholic as a member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Fonda. He also served as a Knight of Columbus.

Bill was a member of the American Legion for over 75 years. In his free time, he enjoyed riding horses and spending time outdoors.

Those left to cherish his memory include his brother, Bob Bradford of Fonda, Iowa; nieces and nephews: Terry Orchard of Poncha Springs, Colorado; Nancy Bertolino of Papillion, Nebraska; Judy Orchard of Council Bluffs, Iowa; Mary Ellen Barela of Omaha, Nebraska; Valerie Orchard of Omaha, Nebraska; extended family and many friends.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents; and sister, Mary Ann Orchard.
