Bill also enjoyed going on long road trips with David for work.

Bill and Tangy enjoyed boating, camping, going to the casino (with Booma), and hanging out with friends. He would look forward to his annual hunting ventures with Brian "Hairball". Bill considered all friends as family and was well known for his quote "Peace, Love always in life".
